INTERSTATE 10 WIDENING: EARLEY ROAD TO JUNCTION INTERSTATE 8 (SEGMENT B)

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is designing roadway improvements for Interstate 10, from Val Vista Road to Junction I-8. The project is divided into two segments – Segment A: Val Vista Road to Earley Road, located in Casa Grande, and Segment B: Earley Road to Junction I-8, located just south of Casa Grande. The design for Segment A is complete, and construction is anticipated to begin by the end of 2010. Segment B is currently in design.

The proposed improvements for both segments include widening I-10 from two lanes to three lanes in each direction. Improvements specific to Segment B include:

- ✓ Rubberized asphalt paving
- ✓ Florence Boulevard ramp upgrades
- ✓ Remove existing traffic interchange at Jimmie Kerr Boulevard
- ✓ Two new I-10 bridges over Jimmie Kerr Boulevard and the Union Pacific Railroad
- ✓ New U-turn at Jimmie Kerr Boulevard
- ✓ New one-way frontage roads from Selma Highway to Jimmie Kerr Boulevard
- ✓ Add a new traffic interchange at Selma Highway
- ✓ Selma Highway increased from one lane to two lanes in each direction at its intersection with I-10
- ✓ Pave Hacienda Road from Earley Road to Selma Highway

The goal of the project is to increase capacity and improve traffic operations and safety.

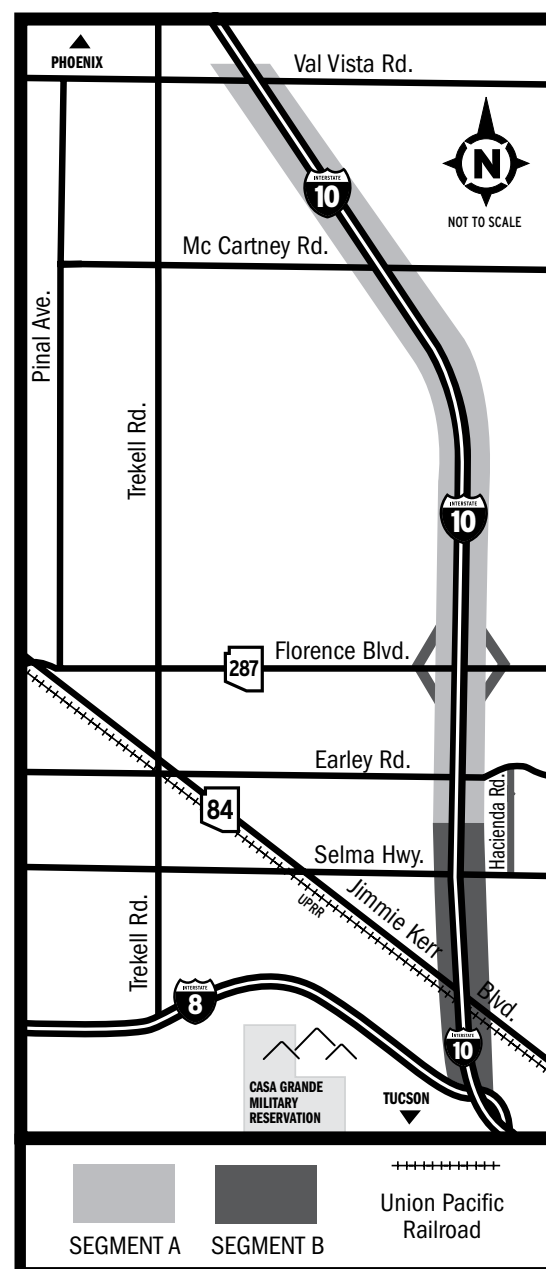
PROJECT SCHEDULE (subject to change)

SEGMENT A: VAL VISTA ROAD TO EARLEY ROAD

- Construction is anticipated to begin by the end of 2010, with a duration of two years.

SEGMENT B: EARLEY ROAD TO JUNCTION I-8

- Currently in design.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in late 2012, contingent upon funding availability.
