

I-10 WIDENING

Prince Road to 29th Street

Westbound I-10 Access at 6th Avenue

As part of the Arizona Department of Transportation's Interstate 10 Widening project, travelers wishing to use the 6th Avenue entrance ramp to westbound I-10 will not be able to directly enter westbound I-10, but will have the choice of entering the westbound I-10 frontage road or taking southbound I-19. This condition will remain in place for at least one year and is necessary to assure safe access for the traffic coming from 6th avenue.

For access to westbound I-10 from 6th Avenue:

- Travel south on 6th Avenue and take Ajo Way to northbound I-19 and then to westbound I-10.
- Take the westbound I-10 entrance ramp at 6th Avenue, travel the westbound I-10 frontage road for approximately five miles, and enter westbound I-10 at the Prince Road entrance ramp.
- Take the westbound I-10 entrance ramp at 6th Avenue to southbound I-19 to Ajo Way and turn around to get on northbound I-19 to westbound I-10.
- Take the eastbound I-10 entrance ramp to Park Avenue, turn left and get in the right lane to take the second right to the westbound I-10 entrance ramp.

For access to the downtown area between Prince Road and 29th Street from 6th Avenue:

- Take the westbound I-10 entrance ramp at 6th Avenue and travel the westbound I-10 frontage road to the desired cross street.

The current signs directing traffic to I-10 will be adjusted to clarify frontage road access versus freeway access.
