Prince Road to 29th Street

Revised Bridge Removal Schedule

- ▶ **Speedway Boulevard Bridge** – The demolition of the west side of the Interstate 10 Speedway Boulevard bridge is scheduled for Friday, July 20, 2007, at 10 p.m. through Monday, July 23, 2007, at 6 a.m. East and westbound Speedway Boulevard underneath I-10 will be closed during this time.
- ▶ **St. Mary's Road Bridge** – The demolition of the west side of the I-10 St. Mary's Road bridge is scheduled for Friday, July 27, 2007, at 10 p.m. through Monday, July 30, 2007, at 6 a.m. East and westbound St. Mary's Road underneath I-10 will be closed during this time.
- ▶ **Congress Street Bridge** – The demolition of the east side of the I-10 Congress Street bridge is scheduled to begin on Friday, August 3, 2007, at 10 p.m. through Monday, August 6, 2007, at 6 a.m. East and westbound Congress Street underneath I-10 will be closed during this time.
- ▶ **22nd Street Bridge** – The demolition of the east side of the I-10 22nd Street bridge is scheduled for Friday, August 10, 2007, at 10 p.m. through Monday, August 13, 2007, at 6 a.m. East and westbound 22nd Street underneath I-10 will be closed during this time.
- ▶ **Granada Avenue/Clark Street Bridge** – The demolition of the east side of the I-10 Granada Avenue/Clark Street bridge is scheduled to begin on Friday, August 17, 2007, at 10 p.m. Granada Avenue/Clark Street will remain closed underneath I-10 in both directions until further notice.
- ▶ The 18th Street pedestrian underpass is closed for the duration of the project.

Each bridge demolition is scheduled to last through Monday at 6 a.m. During this time, a full weekend road closure of the specific arterial roads under I-10 will be required. Upon re-opening, the traffic lanes will be restricted, but the normal traffic patterns will be maintained. This is necessary for the safety of the traveling public as well as the workers involved with the removal. The contractor will be working 24 hours a day during this period to re-open the road as soon as possible. The demolitions will be done with an excavator equipped with a combination of a hammer and shear to remove the structures. No explosives will be used. For safety purposes, no one will be allowed in the demolition area with the exception of the contractor.
