TUCSON – The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is currently constructing a new Marsh Station Traffic Interchange (TI) approximately 1.6 miles east of the existing Marsh Station Traffic Interchange. This American Recovery and Reinvestment Act project includes the extension of the Marsh Station Road, drainage improvements and new pavement markings. The project also includes realigning approximately 3 miles of the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) line to the north side of I-10.

When complete, the new TI, together with the removal of the low clearance UPRR bridge over Interstate 10, will provide adequate clearance for over height trucks, eliminating the need to make a 65 mile detour through Benson, Sonoita and other neighboring communities.

Currently, construction is taking place outside of interstate travel and impacts on the traveling public will be minimal.

Later phases of construction will include a weekend closure of I-10 so that the existing bridge structure can be demolished safely. Motorists will be advised well in advance of this event so that alternate travel plans can be made. The bridge demolition is tentatively scheduled to take place in the fall of 2010.

ADOT advises drivers to proceed with caution, obey all posted speed limit signs and be alert for construction equipment and personnel.
