

Westbound Interstate 10 lane closure near the new Marsh Station traffic interchange scheduled Thursday

TUCSON — The Arizona Department of Transportation will close the right lane of westbound Interstate 10 just west of the Empirita Road exit (near the new Marsh Station traffic interchange) from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday (March 10). The lane restriction will allow crews to install a sign in this area.
