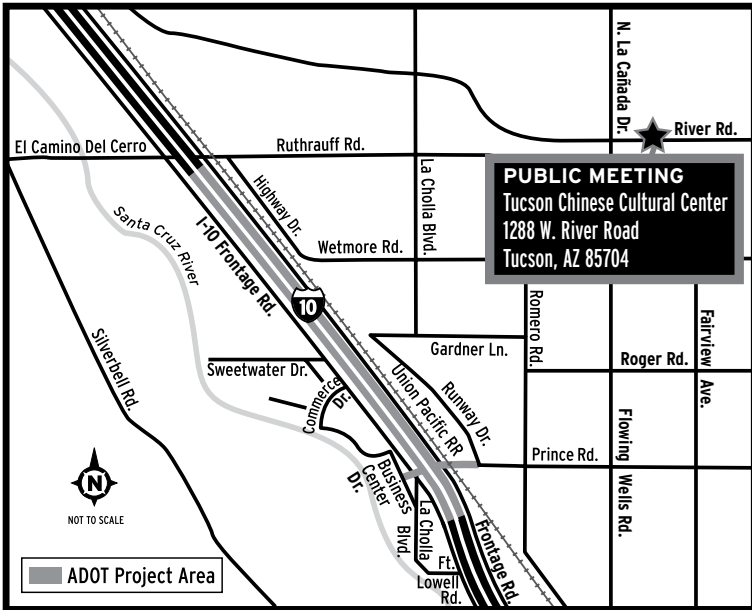

# I-10: Ruthrauff Road to Prince Road Improvements **PUBLIC MEETING**

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration, is holding an informational public meeting to present the final design and construction schedule for the Interstate 10 (I-10) improvement project from Ruthrauff Road to Prince Road. ADOT representatives will be available to answer questions and address concerns.

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct the I-10 and Prince Road traffic interchange so that Prince Road would pass over the Union Pacific railroad tracks and I-10, and to widen the interstate to four lanes in each direction. Through the construction of an overpass, this project would relieve traffic congestion and eliminate delays at the railroad crossing on Prince Road by separating traffic from the railroad tracks. Construction is anticipated to begin in early 2011.
